PHYSICAL ACTIVITY / RISKS

Rescue Training Inc., has trained some of America's most elite fighting warriors, some of whom are currently OCONUS employing the skills practiced in this course. This training requires strenuous physical activity, especially during the field training exercises.

Students will be exposed to a variety of conditions, which may include, but not limited to:

- CS or other riot control agents
- Water Borne Hazards / Drown Proofing
- Blank firing weapons / Paintballs
- Pyrotechnics (smoke & distraction devices) / Flash-bangs
- Darkness with austere field conditions
- Field training under rigorous and demanding psychological stress
- Simulated tactical operations
- Operating in tactical gear during extreme weather conditions including heat, cold and precipitation

Applicants who are not in excellent physical condition and who do not participate in a regular physical conditioning program should seek the approval of their physician before participating.

Providing out-of-hospital care in the austere environment of a tactical law enforcement mission requires special judgment and skills not taught in standard EMT curricula. The EMT-Tactical course is designed to fill the gap in training which has become more apparent as the violence associated with drug activity and terrorism continues to increase. This is accomplished by enhancing the participants' ability to support a tactical law enforcement team and survive a violent street encounter..
